Application Process

1

Complete the **Application for Enrolment as Part-time Student** and **Personal Statement**. You should refer to the accompanying **Guidance Notes to Assist in Your Application**. We cannot proceed with your application until we have received these forms.

Ask a leader of your home congregation to write a **Letter of Recommendation** on your behalf. This should say how long they have known you and something about your suitability as a student of the British Bible School. This may be returned separately or with your **Application** and **Statement**.

Once we have received all appropriate forms and letters we will process your application. You will then be sent your first Module Resource Pack along with other introductory material.

General

1. Before you complete the Application Form, please ensure that you have read through the Prospectus and other accompanying information.
2. Please complete each section as appropriate, writing clearly in block letters, paying particular attention to difficult or unusual words.
3. When completed, please send it to the address at the foot of the page along with your personal letter of application and photograph.
4. All information you provide will be kept confidential and shared only with those directly involved in your studies.

Specific Details

5. If you do not have a personal e-mail address, please try to include one to which you have access.
6. This should be the Christian assembly of which you are most regularly an active part.
7. Please include information about any specific Bible training you have had, in addition to basic information about general education levels and attainment.
