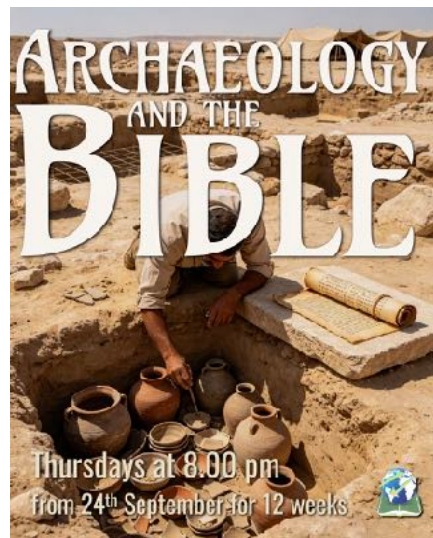
Abraham and Sons
